The EPJ (<http://www.epj.org/>) which has nine topical sections covering all branches and topics of physics and EPJC covers Particles & Fields. EPJ has been born from the merger and continuation of Acta Physica Hungarica, Anales de Fisica, Czechoslovak Journal of Physics, Fizika A, Il Nuovo Cimento, Journal de Physique, Portugaliae Physica and Zeitschrift für Physik.

EPJC covers high energy and particle physics, astroparticle physics, early Universe cosmology and experimental particle physics. According to the journal website (<http://www.springer.com/physics/particle+and+nuclear+physics/journal/10052>) its impact factor is 3.248 and ranks 9 (after journals such as Rev. Mod. Phys, Phys. Rev. Lett., Phys. Rev. D, Phys. Lett. B, Nucl. Phys. B, JHEP and JCAP). Prof. Sheikh-Jabbari will be among the six editors of the journal in Theoretical Physics II sector.
